# **Criterias for providing hostel facilities**

These criterias are implemented from 01.01.2016 (As amended in the meeting held with the Vice Chancellor on 31.12.2015)

Hostel facilities will not be provided for

- 1. Married students.
- 2. Students those who are residence of less than 25km distance.
- 3. Students who have violated hostel rules in previous years.

According to the criteria, the factors of awarding marks and the amount of marks awarded are as follows. (Total marks 1000)

- e) Students from families whose parents are in military (disabled)
- f) Other special factors
