N.B.

- 1. Hostel facilities are provided based on criteria approved by the university since there are very limited number of facilities in the hostels.
- 2. Hostel application must be certified by the Divisional Secretary and Gramasevaka of the area. Applications that are not certified will be rejected.
- 3. If you are a student from a Samurdhi beneficiary family, the relevant Samurdhi certificate must be certified by the Samurdhi Officer and the Divisional Secretary of your area.
- 4. If medical reports are submitted, the relevant medical reports must be certified by a government doctor and certified by the Chief Medical Officer of the university Medical Centre.
- 5. All applicants must note that the relevant applications must submit to the Student Welfare Division by signing the book kept in the Division.
- 6. Applications will not be accepted after due date for any reason and incomplete applications will be rejected.
- 7. Hostel facilities will not be provided to any student without hostel application form.
